Review the Employee Handbook or Policies

Start by reviewing your company's employee handbook or policies. Look for sections related to charitable giving, corporate social responsibility, or any mentions of donation matching programs. It might provide specific details on how the program works and how to participate.

Inquire with Human Resources (HR)

Reach out to your company's HR department or your HR representative. They should have information about any donation matching programs available to employees. You can send them an email or schedule a meeting to discuss your inquiry. Be sure to mention your interest in making charitable donations and your desire to know if the company offers a matching program.

Talk to Colleagues

Engage in conversations with your colleagues, especially those who have been with the company for a longer time.
